**MANSFIELD AUTISM PRACTITIONERS (MAPS) DELIVER IN HOME FAMILY AND EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT FOR CLIENTS OVER A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS. MAPS SUPPORT CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE AGED 2 - 16 YEARS.**

MAPs work alongside families to offer an individual plan of support. This plan will vary according to the needs of the family and MAPs will work collaboratively with families to prioritise areas of need.

The role of the MAP is to assist families to develop the skill and confidence to work and live

with their child/children who have an Autism Spectrum Disorder.

This is achieved by:

- Helping to identify & prioritise goals
- Help to develop strategies which suit the needs of the individual client & family
- Make recommendations using a Positive Behaviour Support framework
- Model strategies alongside parents
- Act as a Parent Advocate at meetings
- Assist with networking families to appropriate services and resources
- In-servicing and working with educational, recreational, respite and other services which are involved with the client

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
