

Mansfield Therapeutic Residential Placement - Information to give to your NDIS Planner

MASS Purpose: To transform the lives of Victorian children and families living with autism

Mansfield Autism Statewide Services is a registered NDIS provider of Specialist Behaviour Intervention, Improved Daily Living and Short-Term accommodation. We are registered with the Quality and Safeguards Commission as delivering Specialist Behaviour Intervention Support as well as an implementing provider in delivery of supports to NDIS participants. We have specialist accommodation at our residence in Mansfield for children and young people with autism.

What is the Therapeutic Residential Placement?

Our Service: We offer an intensive model of therapeutic support over a nine-week period. Our model is a 24/7 care model which provides a highly supportive and consistent environment structured to reduce anxieties and build capacity to learn new skills. Our autism practitioners (MAP's) then support the transition of the skills learnt at the Therapeutic Placement into the home environment. Our MAP's, where possible, will live with families to integrate the strategies back home. Our therapeutic program is purposefully designed with activities such as yoga, swimming, and equine facilitated learning to reduce anxious behaviours. All clients participate in these activities alongside individualised and tailored interventions that are developed through a Behaviour Support Plan.

Our Approach: Evidence based - our staff use Positive Behaviour Supports and practices when working with our clients. We specialise in building skills and developing practical intervention strategies that can be transferred to the home environment.

The placement is flexible and responsive to individual needs. As a guide we seek to build client skills within the following domains:

- Daily Living Skills such as toileting, self-care, personal hygiene
- Eating Programs
- Sleep hygiene
- Routines: night-time, morning and after school routines
- Social and Communication skills
- Emotion Regulation

Access Criteria: All Victorian clients with a diagnosis of autism, from the age of 6 -18 years may attend. Therapeutic Placements have a limited capacity - for those we are unable to accommodate during the current NDIS plan period, we will confirm in writing when the next residential placement dates are available. We are unable to hold places without funding approval within a client's NDIS plan.

What do our families say?

"The education that we received was unbelievable. After parenting this child for 11 years and having no idea what was going on, I am now more aware of how my son thinks".

How do families access our Therapeutic Placement?

Families require specific funding, as per fee schedule on the following page.

All families will need to contact MASS and provide us with a copy of their child's autism diagnosis. We will then arrange a time to meet with the family to conduct an Initial Access Interview. All families will be given a schedule of support and service agreement outlining cost and dates of service.
