Autistic young people meet and support each other. Parents connect and have time out together. Siblings enjoy their own program. Camps provide parents with much needed respite, as children are supported for the duration of the camp by trained staff.

We ditch the screens and engage in simple activities for health and wellbeing. We love getting outdoors and enjoying nature.

Camp-Based

Our MAPs stay in the home which helps to observe critical times and to provide individualised and relevant ideas and strategies that fit in with the family routine. We provide continuity of care, supporting our young people through times of transition and change.

A Range of Activities

We offer a camp that has a balanced program of relaxation, outdoor experiences, nature, art and craft, yoga, games, healthy foods and exercise.

Family Camp Information

Participants require NDIS funding in their Core and Improved Daily Living budgets

Key details:

- We provide educational workshops for parents to learn more about autism and how to support their child.
- Camps are held at our beautiful 100 acre farm in Mansfield, Victoria.
- Camps provide parents with much needed respite, as children are supported for the duration of the camp.
- Each autistic young person has a 1:1 support worker for the duration of the camp.
- Accommodation is in three bedroom cabins with views over Mt Buller.
- Siblings are supported in small peer to peer groups.
- Camps provide parents with much needed respite, as children are supported for the duration of the camp.
- Families enjoy quality time together and have fun.
- Our camp sizes are small. Each camp supports up to 10 autistic young people and their families.
- Our camps run from Monday to Saturday for five nights.
- Camps are for autistic young people up to the age of 18 years and their families.
- All camps are fully catered (family fee covers meals for the family).
- Family camps have a limited capacity. We will confirm availability following a service request.

In our service, we aim to:

- Build daily living skills, self care, social and emotional skills, independence, and communication.
- Enable parents, siblings and autistic young people to build social networks and reduce social isolation.
- Enhance family relationships and increase understanding of autism.
- Build capacity of parents and siblings to maintain informal supports of their autistic child/sibling.
